FROM THE HEART OF OUR PASTOR

My ECF Family:

2023 started with great expectations and a strong word from the Lord to "ENGAGE". To Engage Home, Heaven and Hell. That we were to be intentional about reaching those in our circle of influence, our "Oikos" as we learn from the word as it relates to our family, friends and close relationships. As well as to be intentional about our quiet time with the Lord and reaching those around us, also our church that don't know the Lord and that are far from Him. This is our engagement with Heaven and Hell.

The year began with our average Attendance in our live 10:30 service at around 100 to 150 per Sunday. Our online attendance was averaging around 200 to 300 devices that login to hear our messages from Sunday Morning.

To date because of our Obedience to the command to "Engage" our Sunday Morning attendance as literally doubled to 250 to 300. Our online attendance has remained the same, with devices as high as 400 to 450 depending on the sermon topic. Yet, our daily morning devotion 7:14 on Youtube and Facebook is increasing in subscriptions and followers. Our Facebook followers are now over 6100 and we had a goal for our Youtube subscribers to reach over 3000 by the end of this year, currently we are at 2960. I have no doubt that we are going reach 3000 by December 31.

Let me tell you that all of this is due to your faithfulness to do what God has commanded us to do, when He told us to Engage. Your obedience has produced the growth we are experiencing. A specific proof of God's approval to our obedience is the increase of Youth and Young Adults who have chosen to make ECF their Church home. I'm especially encouraged by this, because it is saying that God intends for ECF to have a future even after we have transitioned to Glory.

Can I tell how proud I am to be your Pastor. I know I have said this before, but I am. Especially as I see the fruit that God is producing through us for Kingdom and for our benefit.

In 2024, I feel strongly that God wants to take us to another level of growth and intimacy with Him. Part of that would be us experiencing our in-person service breaking the 500 mark in attendance. Which will take us to another level of involvement and resourcing for Kingdom work. How are we going to do that? you might ask — by doing what God has given us to do. By Picking Up the Broken Pieces in the Lives of People and Creating Authentic Christians —by continuing to ENGAGE!! In 2024 our theme is "ENGAGE 2.0", which means being even more intentional about reaching those around us in our home and in our neighborhood. By being even more intentional about growing deeper in our intimacy with God, by being faithful in Quiet time, Bible Study and church attendance. And by being even more intentional about our involvement in the various ministries at ECF to reach the lost and those that are far from Him.

God has blessed us! Not just with increase in attendance and involvement; also in the area of resources. Our Giving is increasing as well. WE ARE NOT WHERE WE SHOULD BE, but we are increasing more and more, as more of us are becoming more trusting and obedient to tithes and offerings. I'm anticipating that in 2024, we are going to see these and greater miracles, as we continue to walk by faith and not by sight.

Hey family, follow me as I follow Christ, and together let's see what God has in store for us in 2024.
