Standing Firm! Overview of 2 Thessalonians: Standing Firm in the Midst of Suffering 2 Thessalonians 1:1-12 NKJV Dr. Joshua Beckley, Senior Pastor

INTRODUCTION

Sequel to 1 Thessalonians:

- It is written just a few months later while Paul is in Corinth.
- Some misunderstood his teaching about the second coming of Christ.
- Christ could come at any moment some reasoned no point in working every day.
- Many stopped working, just sitting around waiting for Christ's return.
- Using prophecy as an excuse, surviving off the generosity of the others.
- Others viewed continuing persecution as a sign of "the day of the Lord" or the last days.

Responding quickly, Paul sends this second epistles to the young church.

Reminder: Lord will return! In the meantime,

- Live responsibly in light of the truth of Gospel
- STAND FIRM in the faith and obedience to the Word of God

Paul's concerns: Right doctrine and Right living:

- Begins by commending their faith in Christ.
- Consoles these victims of suffering and persecution.
- Christ will return and reward the faithful / punish the wicked.
- Paul prays that God will be glorified through their faithful and consistent service.

Paul prays they would STAND FIRM IN MIDST OF SUFFERING!

What does it mean to Stand Firm in our Faith?

"to refuse to change a decision or position; it also means to defy, to hold, to hold up, to withstand, to resist or confront with resistance; it also means to be brave, to endure, to weather, to face with courage."

The Collins online English dictionary

"Stand firm" - to be or remain steadfast in conviction despite attack, or efforts to persuade.

God would have us stand firm in our Faith! (armor of God, Ephesian 6).

STAND FIRM IN THREE WAYS:

1. STAND FIRM IN _____

- 2 Thessalonians 1:3-5 NKJV

What does it mean to persevere?

continue in a course of action even in the face of difficulty or with little or no prospect of success; to continue to do or try to achieve something despite discouragement.

Paul tells the Thessalonican believers that they have displayed perseverance through:

- Growing in their Faith because your faith grows exceedingly...
- Abounding in their Love for each other the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other...
- Patience and Faith in their persecution and Tribulation for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure...

2. STAND FIRM IN _____

- 2 Thessalonians 1:6-10 NKJV

Approximately 8,810 *promises* in the entire Bible.

7,706 in Old Testament - 1,104 in New Testament - *133 in Deuteronomy 28, most in any chapter.

Vance Havner, "We're sitting on the premises when we ought to be standing on the promises!"

What is the Promise in this passage?

- a) To repay those who trouble us! (v.6)...God to repay with tribulation those who trouble you...
- b) To give rest to us who are in Christ!
 (v.7)... and to give you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus...
- c) To exact vengeance upon those who don't know God and have chosen to disobey the Gospel! (v.8)... taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel...
- d) To glorify us with Him when He returns! (v.10)... when He comes, in that Day, to be glorified in His saints and to be admired among all those who believe...

3. STAND FIRM IN _____

Certainty that is rooted in that which is known or proved to be true Indisputable

- 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12 NKJV
- **Power** "dynamei" = (dynamic) ability;
- Jesus said in Luke 10:19 NKJV "power = dynamin."

We Stand Firm in the midst of Suffering through Power, by:

- 1. Prayer (v.11a) we also pray always for you...
- 2. Faith (v.11b) fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and the work of faith with power...
- 3. Grace -(v.12) according to the <u>grace</u> of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
