SCRIPTURE - Luke 1:26-33 NKJV

INTRODUCTION

The incarnation and conception of our blessed Saviour.

- Six months after the conception of John
- Angel Gabriel sent to make known to Zacharias God's purpose concerning *Jesus, Son of God*
- Sent also to Mary
- Glorious work of redemption *begun* with Zacharias
- Now Glorious work of redemption *carried on with Mary*.
- Zachariah's son is forerunner of his cousin, Jesus!

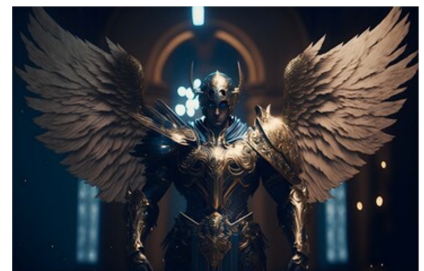
The Prophetic Proclamation proclaims the birth of the one who would save His people from their sins.

FOUR MOVEMENTS OF THE PROPHETIC PROCLAMATION

1) THE _____ - Luke 1:26-28a NKJV

- God visited Sarah! - Gen.21:1 NKJV
- God visited Hannah! - 1 Sam.2:21 NKJV
- God visited the Gentiles! - Acts 15:14 NKJV
- Has God visited You?



2) THE _____ - Luke 1:28b and 1:30b NKJV

- *Veneration* means to regard with great respect; to revere.
 - God does the same thing with us if we would pay attention.
 - † Ephesians 2:10 NKJV
 - † 1 Peter 2:9 NKJV
 - † Proverb 23:7a NKJV
 - How do you think of yourself?
 - If it is not as God thinks of you, it's wrong!

3) THE _____ - Luke 1:29-30a NKJV

- The Presence of the Lord should trouble us (Good Trouble); provoking us to reverence and worship of the Lord.
 - Angelic presence often provoked that response - Rev.22:8-9 NKJV
 - Does the Presence of God trouble your spirit in a Good way?
 - Does presence make you want to DO right and BE right?

4) THE _____ - Luke 1:31-33 NKJV; Isaiah 9:6 NKJV
