## THE POWERFUL PROVISION IS...

1. CULTURALLY $\qquad$ - Luke 2:41-42 NKJV
off Passover - 1 of 3 annual festivals, Jewish men required to keep in Jerusalem (Others: Pentecost and Tabernacles)
of" Pilgrims required to practice the Passover for 7 days Exo. 12:15; Lev. 23:8; Deut. 16:3

- Required to stay at least two days

Exo. 23:14-17; 34:23; Deut. 16:16; 1 Sam 1:7, 1:21; 2:19
"fu' Age 12, a boy was prepared for his entry to the religious community at age 13, according to several historical Jewish traditions.
"fi" First sign of His (Jesus) divine heritage.
$\dagger$ God doesn't save us to separate us from our cultural - 1 Chronicles 12:32 NKJV
$\dagger$ God has made provision for us to be Responsive to our Cultural by Christ example and the power of the Holy Spirit...
2. CULTURALLY - Luke 2:43-50 NKJV
"f" They would have been traveling in a large caravan, with other pilgrims.
"fi" They therefore went for a whole day's journey (about 20-25 miles).
"fo The three days consisted of:

- $1^{\text {st }}$ day - outward journey
- $\quad 2^{\text {nd }}$ day - return to Jerusalem
- $3^{\text {rd }}$ day - the search for him
"f" Found him... in the temple, sitting in the midst of the teachers, both listening to them and asking them questions.
- "Question" (Greek: eperotao) meaning to ask for, request or interrogate...
- Hebrews 5:8 NKJV - He sought to be relatable by Q \& A
$\dagger$ The Mistake the Church often makes in reaching our Culture, the assumption we know what it is and what they need, without -listening to them and asking them questions!
$\dagger 1$ Corinthians 9:19-22 - To be effective in reaching our current culture with the issues it is facing we are going have be more Like Jesus, and take some time listen and question!!!


## 3. CULTURALLY

 - Luke 2:51-52 NKJV"f" This event was an unveiling of Jesus' relationship with his Father (Col. 3:20).
"fi' Nevertheless, the incident has shown, that Jesus' obedience to his parents lies within a more fundamental relationship to God.
"f" The whole birth story closes with a note of Jesus' continued growth to manhood.
"f' "Increase" (Greek: prokopto) means 'to progress, advance.
Original sense: to make one's way forward by chopping away obstacles.
Wisdom and stature - maturity associated with increasing age (Eph. 3:16; 4:13).
"f" "Favor" (Greek: charis ...[grace]) with both God and man

- 1 Samuel 2:26 NKJV
- Luke 2:40 NKJV
"f" Jesus next appears - as One ready to be consecrated to his task.
$\dagger$ He is Our Powerful Provision for Our Salvation and Deliverance!!!
$\dagger$ He is our Provision for whatever we need not matter where we are!
